In spring/early summer they have bedding plants available for sale. In the summer/early fall they sell strawberries, raspberries, and vegetables fresh from their family farm. In late November/early December they sell Christmas trees. They sell their fresh produce at the Tabusintac Country Market every Saturday morning 7:30am to 11:00am in the Tabusintac Community Hall.

Also available to order are antibiotic free poultry- chickens and turkeys. Poultry is one of the foods where one can easily taste the difference that farm fresh and free range makes. Their birds are raised without the use of antibiotics and furthermore, most of their grain is grown and milled directly on the farm.



CSA (Community Supported Agriculture)



What is a CSA?

CSA allows city residents to have direct access to high quality, fresh produce grown locally by regional farmers.

When you become a member of a CSA, you're purchasing a "share" of vegetables from a regional farmer. Weekly or bi-weekly, your farmer will deliver that share of produce to a convenient drop-off location in your neighborhood.

- 18 weeks of organic vegetables and fruits (early summer to early fall) delivered to four of two locations in Miramichi, Rogersville, Moncton or Dieppe

Community Food Mentors

About the Community Food Mentor Program

Food is a part of everyone's life; it connects us all. However, issues involving food and food security are becoming increasingly complex. Today we are faced with many food choices, conflicting information about diet and health, limited time for meal preparation and questions about how and where our food is grown. Some face additional challenges such as living on low income, limited transportation, limited kitchen facilities or limited food knowledge and preparation skills.

Community Food Mentors (CFMs) are a province-wide network of certified individuals who share their skills in food and nutrition within their own communities. The goals of this program are to build partnerships and community capacity to increase food security in New Brunswick by addressing these challenges.

The Goal of the Community Food Mentor Program is to develop a network of dedicated food mentors in New Brunswick communities through a shared learning experience that will increase the exchange of information on food skills, healthy eating practices and local food sourcing in the province.
